

How to Use the Wireless

Welcome! The following general SSIDs are provided:

- **NLNOG-Day2022** (WPA2 802.1X, 2.4GHz and 5 GHz)
- **NLNOG-Day2022-insecure** (open, 2.4 GHz and 5 GHz)
- **eduroam** (2.4 GHz and 5 GHz)

You can use **nl-nog** / **nl-nog** or **guest** / **guest** when using MS-CHAPv2 inside TTLS or PEAP, or choose any username/password combination when connecting with PAP inside TTLS.

The SHA256 fingerprint of the server's certificate is:

AF:88:FE:17:31:B1:4E:4A:E9:A2:20:93:4B:51:A5:09:CE:AF:84:E6:80:76:01:45:F8:6A:3E:BC:6F:2A:34:5C

The subject CN on the certificate is radius.eventinfra.org. It is signed by Let's Encrypt for your convenience, though the fingerprint is the thing to check.

Extra: by default inbound traffic to your device is only allowed from the event-network.

Use **outboundonly** / **outboundonly** as username/password to only allow outbound traffic from your device, giving you basic protection and a way to save battery usage. Alternatively, use **allowany** / **allowany** as username/password to allow any inbound traffic to your device from the internet (and event-network).
