

# How to Use the Wireless

Welcome! The following general SSIDs are provided:

- **NLNOG-Day2024** (WPA3 802.1X, 2.4GHz, 5 GHz and 6GHz)
- **NLNOG-Day2024-open** (open/OWE, 2.4 GHz, 5 GHz and 6GHz)
- **eduroam** (2.4 GHz, 5 GHz and 6GHz)

You can use **nlhog** / **nlhog** or **guest** / **guest** when using MS-CHAPv2 inside TTLS or PEAP, or choose any username/password combination when connecting with PAP inside TTLS.

The SHA256 fingerprint of the server's certificate is:

**47:77:C3:01:3D:C8:93:D8:94:AF:58:C3:92:30:52:5D:71:57:AE:53:79:75:03:6E:2A:2F:F5:AF:10:55:65:37**

The subject CN on the certificate is radius.eventinfra.org. It is signed by Let's Encrypt for your convenience, though the fingerprint is the thing to check.

Extra: by default inbound traffic to your device is only allowed from the event-network.

Use **outboundonly** / **outboundonly** as username/password to only allow outbound traffic from your device, giving you basic protection and a way to save battery usage. Alternatively, use **allowany** / **allowany** as username/password to allow any inbound traffic to your device from the internet (and event-network).
